

NORTH HAVEN, L.I.

The following single stone was found concealed in a swampy brier patch while running a line for the surveyors. It is hard to get at, and was probably a small private cemetery of the Duvall family. If more are buried there, which is doubtful, no stones have been erected.

William Duvall, died of old age, November 16, 1797, aged 78 years.

2. Sacred to the Memory of Mr. Silas Payne, who departed this life, October 27, 1794, aged 29 years, 9 months, and 6 days.
"Stop reader, shed a mournful tear
Upon the dust which slumbers here
And while you read the state of me
Think on the glass which runs for thee."
3. In Memory of Mrs. Jemima Payne, wife of Mr. Silas Payne, who died July 4, 1787 aged 21 years
"Behold and see as you pass by
As you are now, so once was I
As I am now, so you must be
Prepare for death and follow me."
4. In Memory of Mr. John Payne, who died November 1, 1813, aged 77 years.
5. In Memory of Hannah, wife of Samuel Rider, Died November 26, 1799, in the 44th. year of her age.

- # 2: Capt. Joshua Rogers, died February 27, 1846, aged 33 years.
- # 3: Mary, daughter of Jonah & Sally Rogers, died August 2, 1850, aged 22 years.
- # 4: Sally, wife of Capt. Jonah Rogers, died May 10, 1846, aged 65 years.

Captain Jonah Rogers is buried here also, but has no grave stone.
