- # 1: This Stone erected by their fellow citizens as a tribute for respect to the Memory of Nath'l Baker, and John Pierson, who were unfortunately killed in this Place, Feb'y. 25, 1815, while celebrating the return of peace between the United States and Great Britain, their age 22 years. The accidental discharge of a cannon caused their death.
- # 2: \_\_\_\_\_ Baker; The rest of the inscription is missing, but it was probably the wife of Nathaniel J. Baker, above, as he was married and had 1 child, who later lived in East Hampton, L.I.
- # 3: In Memory of David  
Bates son of Cap. Isachar  
& Mrs Hannah Bates of  
Thompson, Connecticut  
who died at Sagg-Harb  
our, Sept. 13th 1789  
in the 20th year of his  
age.
- # 4: Captain Richard R. Beckwith; died of the Cholera, July 23, 1832, aged 32 years.
- # 5: Captain Lester Beebe; born June 12, 1754, died November 4, 1832, in his 79th year. (The Stone is missing.) (\*)
- # 6: Bethiah Beebe; wife of Captain Lester Beebe, born June 15, 1759, died January 12, 1823, by her grave-stone, while the Beebe Family Bible, says "died February 17, 1823, and the Records of the Sag Harbor Presbyterian Church, says, "died January 16, 1823.". (\*)
- # 7: Lester Beebe, Jr., son of Captain Lester & Mrs Bethiah Beebe, born May 10, 1778, died July 13, 1796, in his 19th year. (\*)  
(The Grave-Stone, a red sandstone, has spalled away so that the inscription is almost gone, all that is left is the following " Let Rebi died July 13, 1796, in his 19th year. A small red footstone is lettered L.B.
- # 8: Jason Beebe, (Son of Captain Lester & Mrs Bethiah Beebe, born June 7, 1787, died September 2, 1835, aged 48 years. (\*)
- # 9: Alletta Beebe, wife of Jason Beebe, born August 20, 1793, died June 2, 1838, aged 45 years. (\*)
- # 10: Captain Thomas Beebe, born \_\_\_\_\_, 1764, died August 21, 1822. (\*)  
(The rest of the inscription is illegible.)
- # 11: Nancy Beebe, Relict of Captain Thomas Beebe, born December 25, 1764, died February 20, 1832, aged 67 years. (\*)
- # 12: Lester Beebe, son of Captain Thomas & Mrs Nancy Beebe, died November 18, 1834, aged 36 years.

(\*) Birth dates from the Beebe Family Bible.)

# 72: In Memory of Sarah Fordham, wife of Esquire Nathan Fordham, born 1735, died November 12, 1805. (Note: This couple died within 11 hours of each other, and were buried in the same grave, on the same day. Their grave stone, a tall grayish white sandstone, was still standing as late as 1948, but the inscription had disappeared due to the spalling of the entire face of the soft stone, and the stone has since been removed. It stood next to the stone of Captain Daniel Fordham, very near to Sagg Street.) L.T.Vail.

" In Memory of William, aged 18 yrs, 7 mo, & John, aged 16 yrs, 5 mos, sons of Smith and Catherine Hatfield, who were drowned in Gardiner's Bay, by the swamping of a sail boat, Sept. 12th., 1843. 10 days after the accident their bodies were found and brought to this place and interred.  
" Put thy trust in no man in the hour of danger, for when these boys were drowned men fled from the rescue."

There are also quite a large number of small red sandstones in this Cemetery which are unreadable, due to the spalling of the stones on account of age, and also many burials, which probably never had any stones erected to the deceased. It is said that there is a list of the grave stones, which were readable in 1840, but it cannot be found at the present time. The records of the Presbyterian Church at Sag Harbor, L.I., gives a large list of the deaths in Sag Harbor, from May 30, 1795, to October 26, 1833, from which time until March 13, 1866, the Church Records of deaths, if kept, have been lost. It is supposed that the Rev. J.A. Copp, who was the Pastor during most of that time did not record them. The Sag Harbor Newspapers and The Long Island Star, published in Brooklyn, however have in their files records of many vital statistics.
