"Refugees of 1776 from Long Island to Connecticut" Mather says, " Beebe Lester 6, Capt. (Samuel 5,4,3,2,John1)-From Southold. On Jan 11, 1783 he was permitted to go to L.I. and bring off money & c. for his family. He was captured by the enemy; but paid for his liberty. After the War he remove to Sag Harbor, and later, in company with Henry Ekford, became a noted ship builder in N.Y. City. He lived in Flushing for Several years.(Griffin's "Journal" pp. 156-158)

In 1820 the Beebe Mill was built by Samuel Schellinger, millwright from Amagansett and his apprentice, Pardon Tabor. Lester Beebe owned this mill, his son Jason put it up for sale in 1835.
