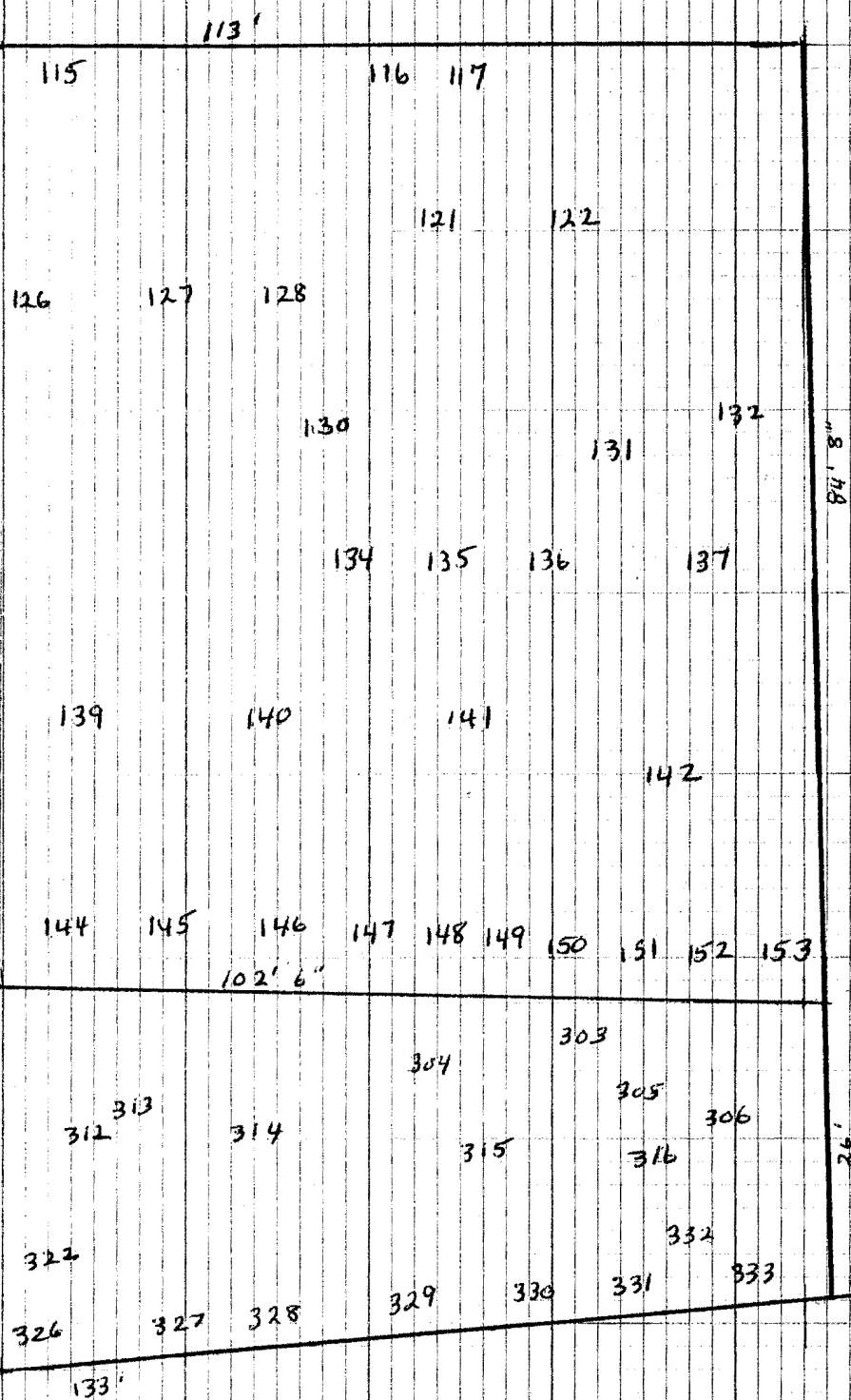

Schellinger, Daniel; died February 1, 1835, ae 50.

Slate, Rachel; wife of Oliver Slate, died December 29, 1806, ae 25.

Slate, Rachel; daughter of Oliver and Rachel Slate, died February 21, 1823, ae 6 years, 3 months.

Sleight, Deacon Augustus; died June 28, 1830, ae 25.

Sleight, Mehetable; wife of Deacon Augustus Sleight, died at Sandy Hill, NY, December 3, 1824, ae 40.

Street, Nancy M.; relict of Henry Street, died September 23, 1828, ae 31.

Tabor, Nancy; wife of Pardon Tabor, also two children, died November 15, 1815, ae 35.

Terry, David P.; son of Joshua and Clarissa Terry, an officer on the ship, *Sabrina*, of NY who was struck by a whale off Crozettes, December 25, 1841, and who died December 27, 1841, ae 24.

Wade, Bathsheba M.; wife of Jared Wade Jr. who died March 19, 1843 ae 25, "She died while her husband was at sea."

Wentworth, Frances; wife of Josiah Wentworth, died June 22, 1835, ae 74.

Westfall, Newton E.; native of Virginia, died May 27, 1833, ae 47.

Wolf, Mary F.D.; died December 22, 1843, ae 20.
